Dear Mr. Gorton:

The purpose of this letter is to certify the results of the election conducted by the Board of Personnel Appeals on April 12, 1984, to determine the representative for collective bargaining purposes for certain employees of Yellowstone County, Montana.

There were one-hundred thirty-two (132) employees eligible to vote of which one-hundred twenty-four (124) valid ballots were cast. Sixty-five (65) ballots were cast in favor of Representation by the Montana Public Employees Association, Inc., twenty-five (25) ballots were cast in favor of Representation by the Teamsters and thirty-four (34) ballots were cast in favor of No Representation.

There being a clear majority, the Board hereby certifies the Montana Public Employees Association, Inc., as the exclusive representative for collective bargaining purposes for certain employees of Yellowstone County, Montana.
