The results of the election conducted by the Board of Personnel Appeals on October 7, 1985, to determine the representative for collective bargaining purposes for certain employees of the Montana Youth Treatment Center, Department of Institutions, State of Montana, are as follows:

- 44 - eligible voters
- 29 - valid votes cast
- 22 - Montana Federation of State Employees, MFT, AFT, AFL-CIO
- 7 - No Representation
- 1 - challenged ballot

There being a clear majority, the Board hereby certifies the Montana Federation of State Employees, MFT, AFT, AFL-CIO as the exclusive representative for collective bargaining purposes for all employees of the Montana Youth Treatment Center, Department of Institutions, State of Montana, excluding professional employees, registered nurses and all supervisory, managerial and confidential employees as defined by Section 39-31-103 MCA. This unit shall include, but is not limited to, the following positions: Cook I, II, Custodial Worker I, II, Food Service Worker I, II, Laundry Worker I, II, Licensed Practical Nurse I, II, Maintenance Worker I, II, Medical Records Secretary, Psychiatric Aide I, II, III, Receptionist, Rehabilitation Aide I, II, Transportation Officer I, Word Processing Operator.
