The purpose of this letter is to certify the results of the election conducted by the Board of Personnel Appeals on April 9, 1985 to determine the representative for collective bargaining purposes for certain employees of the Frenchtown School District No. 40.

There were fifty-one (51) employees eligible to vote of which forty-seven (47) valid ballots were cast. Forty-seven (47) ballots were cast in favor of Representation by the Frenchtown Education Association, MEA, NEA, and zero (0) ballots were cast in favor of No Representation.
