The results of the election conducted by the Board of Personnel Appeals on October 3, 1986, to determine the representative for collective bargaining purposes for certain employees of Pine Hills School, Department of Institutions, State of Montana, are as follows:

There being a clear majority, the Board hereby certifies the Montana Public Employees Association as the exclusive representative for collective bargaining purposes for all custodial/maintenance, office/clerical, cooks/kitchen attendants, and security guards employed by Pine Hills School, Department of Institutions, State of Montana, excluding the Maintenance Supervisor II, Secretary III (Superintendent's secretary), Accounting Specialist II, Custodial Supervisor I, Food Service Supervisor II, Warehouse Foreman I, and the Transportation and Security Officer.
