
Dear Mr. Peterson:

The results of the election conducted by the Board of Personnel Appeals on May 14, 1990, to determine the representative for collective bargaining purposes for certain employees of Lake County Sheriff's Department, are as follows:

2	-	No Representation

There being a clear majority, the Board hereby certifies the Montana Public Employees Association as the exclusive representative for collective bargaining purposes for all deputy sheriffs, full and part-time dispatchers, full and part-time jailers and correctional supervisors employed by Lake County excluding sheriffs and undersheriffs.
