The results of the election conducted by the Board of Personnel Appeals on July 23, 1990, to determine the representative for collective bargaining purposes for certain employees of Fergus County, are as follows:

There being a clear majority, the Board hereby certifies the Montana Public Employees Association as the exclusive representative for collective bargaining purposes for all Fergus County Courthouse employees including those employed by the Superintendent of Schools, County Health Nurse, County Probation/Control Officers, custodial staff, Treasurers Office, Clerk and Records Office, Assessors Office, Clerk of Court and City-County Planning Board excluding all managerial employees, supervisory employees, confidential employees and all others exempted by the Montana Collective Bargaining for Public Employees Act, Section 39-31-101 et seq. MCA.
