The results of the election conducted by the Board of Personnel Appeals on May 7, 1990, to determine the representative for collective bargaining purposes for certain employees of Dawson County High School and Dawson County Elementary District No. 1, are as follows:

There being a clear majority, the Board hereby certifies the MONTANA EDUCATION ASSOCIATION, MEA, NEA as the exclusive representative for collective bargaining purposes for employees of Dawson County High School and Dawson County Elementary No. 1 working as classroom aides, K-12, classroom special education aides, library aides, and cooks K-12 excluding those employees excluded by the Collective Bargaining Act (39-31-103, MCA, 1989) and excluding all substitute employees, part-time employees (less than 20 hours per week of bargaining unit work), temporary employees (less than 30 days of bargaining unit work), secretary, clerical, bus drivers, students, and all other employees.
