There being a clear majority, the Board hereby certifies the Montana Education Association as the exclusive representative for collective bargaining purposes for bus drivers, special education aides, teachers aides, custodians, cooks and assistant cooks employed by Power Public School District No. 30 excluding those employees excluded by Section 39-31-103(2)(b) MCA (1989), and also excluding part-time, temporary or substitute employees [those employed for less than 7½ hours per week] and/or those employed for less than thirty (30) consecutive work days in the same position and excluding all other employees.
