The results of the election conducted by the Board of Personnel Appeals on December 2, 1991, to determine the representative for collective bargaining purposes for certain employees of PLAINS SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 1, are as follows:

17	-	eligible voters
12	-	valid votes cast
10	-	MONTANA EDUCATION ASSOCIATION
2	-	No Representation

There being a clear majority, the Board hereby certifies MONTANA EDUCATION ASSOCIATION as the exclusive representative for collective bargaining purposes for maintenance employees, custodians, office personnel, aides, food service employees, nurse and music accompanists excluding those employees exempted by the Montana Collective Bargaining For Public Employees (Section 39-31-101 et seq., MCA) and excluding all substitute employees, part-time employees (those employees working less than five hours per week in the bargaining unit) and temporary employees (employees working less than 30 consecutive days in the bargaining unit) the assistant clerk (superintendent's secretary) maintenance supervisor, lunch supervisors, students, and all other employees.
