The results of the election conducted by the Board of Personnel Appeals on April 8, 1992, to determine the representative for collective bargaining purposes for certain employees of the City of Lewistown, are as follows:

- 0 - No Representation
- 0 - challenged ballots

There being a clear majority, the Board hereby certifies the Lewistown Firefighters Local #3429 as the exclusive representative for collective bargaining purposes for all City employees employed by the City of Lewistown Fire Department including Assistant Fire Chief, Fire Marshall, Captain, Lieutenant and firefighters working a regular shift. Exclusions include all supervisors such as the Fire Chief and all other employees.
