The results of the election conducted by the Board of Personnel Appeals on April 13, 1992, to determine the representative for collective bargaining purposes for certain employees of the Montana Department of Justice, are as follows:

- 30 - eligible voters
- 25 - valid votes cast
- 17 - Montana Public Employees Association
- 8 - No Representation
- 0 - challenged ballots

There being a clear majority, the Board hereby certifies the Montana Public Employees Association as the exclusive representative for collective bargaining purposes for all permanent full-time and permanent part-time Communication Systems Operators (Dispatchers) employed by the Montana Department of Justice, excluding all supervisory, confidential and managerial employees.
