There being a clear majority, the Board hereby certifies the Montana Public Employees Association as the exclusive representative for collective bargaining purposes for all full-time and part-time (20 hours plus per week) clerks in the Record and Driver Control Bureau (formerly Driver Services), Driver Improvement Bureau and Local Exam Stations employed by the State of Montana, Department of Justice excluding any supervisory and managerial personnel.
