The results of the election conducted by the Board of Personnel Appeals on February 14, 1992, to determine the representative for collective bargaining purposes for certain employees of Peerless School Districts No. 2, are as follows:

There being a clear majority, the Board hereby certifies the Montana Education Association as the exclusive representative for collective bargaining purposes for employees employed by Peerless Elementary School District No. 2 and High School District No. 2 who are certified in class I, II IV or V as provided for in Section 20-4-201 MCA and whose position of employment requires certification in class I, II, IV or V as provided for in Section 20-4-106 MCA excluding the superintendent, principal, substitute employees, part-time employees (those working less than three hours per day or 15 hours per week), temporary employees (those employees working less than 30 consecutive days in the bargaining unit), casual employees, all management officials, all confidential employees, all supervisory employees, the school district clerk, school administrators and all those excluded by Section 39-31-103 MCA.
