The results of the election conducted by the Board of Personnel Appeals on November 26, 1993, to determine the representative for collective bargaining purposes for certain employees of Roosevelt County, Montana are as follows:

- 30 - eligible voters
- 17 - valid votes cast
- 10 - Teamsters Local Union No. 2
- 7 - no representation
- 1 - challenge ballot

There being a clear majority, the Board hereby certifies the Chauffeurs, Teamsters, Warehousemen & Helpers, AFL-CIO, Local Union No. 2, of Great Falls, Montana as the exclusive representative for collective bargaining purposes for Deputy Sheriffs, Detectives, Dispatchers, Detention Officers and Office/ Clerical of Roosevelt County, Wolf Point, Montanan, excluding Supervisors as defined in the Act.
