The results of the election conducted by the Board of Personnel Appeals on February 1, 1994, to determine the representative for collective bargaining purposes for certain employees of Ravalli County are as follows:

- 25 - eligible voters
- 23 - valid votes cast
- 20 - Montana District Council of Laborers, Local No. 1334,
LIUNA/AFL-CIO
- 3 - No Representation

There being a clear majority, the Board hereby certifies the Montana District Council of Laborers' Local No. 1334, affiliated with the Laborers' International Union, AFL-CIO, of Missoula, Montana as the exclusive representative for collective bargaining purposes for all Ravalli County Sheriff's Office dispatchers, including office staff, jailers and deputy sheriffs of Ravalli County, Hamilton, Montana, excluding all other Ravalli County employees, Sheriff, Undersheriff, Lieutenant, volunteer employees, managerial employees, supervisory employees, confidential employees and all other exempted by the Montana Collective Bargaining Act for Public Employees.
