The results of the election conducted by the Board of Personnel Appeals on March 21, 2002, to determine the representative for collective bargaining purposes for certain employees of the **MONTANA DEPARTMENT OF LABOR AND INDUSTRY, BUILDING CODE BUREAU**, are as follows:

- 34 - eligible voters
- 31 - valid votes cast
- 23 - No Representation
  - 8 - Montana Public Employees Association
  - 2 - Void Ballot (no signature on return envelope)

There being a clear majority, the Board hereby certifies **NO REPRESENTATION** for collective bargaining purposes for **CERTAIN PUBLIC EMPLOYEES AS DEFINED IN SECTION 39-31-103 MCA (2001) EMPLOYED AS ALL FIELD INSPECTORS INCLUDING BUILDING STANDARDS, ELECTRICAL, PLUMBING/ MECHANICAL, BOILER AND ELEVATOR/LIFT INSPECTORS OF THE BUILDING CODE BUREAU OF THE MONTANA DEPARTMENT OF LABOR AND INDUSTRY**, EXCLUDING SHORT TERM WORKERS AND TEMPORARY EMPLOYEES, AS DEFINED IN 2-18-101 MCA (2001), ALL MANAGERIAL, SUPERVISORY AND CONFIDENTIAL EMPLOYEES AND ALL OTHER BUREAU EMPLOYEES.
