There being a clear majority, the Board hereby certifies the MEA-MFT, NEA, AFT, AFL-CIO as exclusive bargaining representative for collective bargaining purposes for CERTAIN REGISTERED NURSES AS DEFINED IN SECTION 39-32-102 MCA (2005) EMPLOYED AND REGULARLY SCHEDULED TO WORK NO LESS THAN TWENTY HOURS PER WEEK AS REGISTERED NURSES BY THE MONTANA DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES, DISABILITY SERVICES DIVISION, MONTANA DEVELOPMENTAL CENTER IN POSITIONS NUMBERED 69151530, 69151501, 69151500, 69151503 AND 69151502, EXCLUDING SHORT TERM WORKERS AND TEMPORARY EMPLOYEES AS DEFINED IN SECTION 2-18-101 MCA (2005), ALL MANAGERIAL, SUPERVISORY, CONFIDENTIAL EMPLOYEES, ALL THOSE EXEMPTED BY ITEMS i, ii, iii, iv, vii, vii, x, xi OF SUBSECTION B OF SECTION 39-31-103 MCA (2005), MEMBERS OF OTHER BARGAINING UNITS, AND ALL OTHER EMPLOYEES.
