SUBJECT: Unit Determination No. 8-2012 - Election Certification

Dear Superintendent Kloker:

The results of the election conducted by the Board of Personnel Appeals on February 26, 2013, to determine the representative for collective bargaining purposes for certain employees of the Montana City School District No. 27 are as follows:

- 13 - eligible voters
- 9 - valid votes cast
- 6 - MEA-MFT
- 3 - No Representation
- 0 - challenged ballot

There being a clear majority, the Board hereby certifies the MEA-MFT, as the exclusive representative for collective bargaining purposes for all "support staff" including paraprofessional, interpreter, receptionist, library aide, playground supervisor, lunchroom assistant, lunchroom supervisor, food service manager, cook/baker, nurse, classroom cleaner, maintenance, book processor, certified teaching assistant, maintenance/technology or a combination of these positions, EXCLUDING Superintendent, Secretary, Administration, Supervisors, Certified Teachers, Clerk.
